Referral to the shelter: Providers may submit referrals to the shelter through the Coordinated Entry Service (CES) system or by contacting 211

CES referral hours: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Intake Hours: 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

Closed: 8:30 p.m. – 8 a.m.

The purpose of the shelter is to assist homeless individuals with basic needs, social services, and to uncover a pathway towards a sustainable housing opportunity.

Participants must sign a code of conduct and personal release form upon intake into the shelter. Participants who demonstrate a threat to themselves or to others by disturbing the peace or by physical or verbal assault may result in being removed from the shelter, banned for a period of time, or arrested.

The West Ventura County Emergency Shelter Navigation Center is a service of the City of Oxnard, City of Ventura, and the County of Ventura.

Please note that gathering at the Oxnard Armory prior to 5 p.m. is not permitted.
